Hi Kim,

I hope you are doing well! I am not as familiar with programs like SNAP and Medicaid so I checked in with one of my colleagues. He said that some funds provided by CARES Act and Families First count towards eligibility to programs and others do not. For example, extra unemployment benefits received during the pandemic are not counted towards Medicaid but are counted towards your SNAP income threshold. Others, such as the Recovery Rebate checks are not countable as income toward any means tested program.

Medicaid and Social Security: Unemployment benefits are typically countable income under both Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) and non-MAGI financial methodologies. However, section 2104(h) of the CARES Act states: "The monthly equivalent of any Federal pandemic unemployment compensation paid to an individual under this section shall be disregarded when determining income for any purpose under the programs established under titles XIX [the Medicaid program] and title XXI [the CHIP program] of the Social Security Act." States must disregard the \$600 weekly Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (monthly equivalent of \$2,580) in determining underlying income eligibility, and the scope of assistance (e.g., cost-sharing, post-eligibility treatment-of-income), for both Medicaid and CHIP.

SNAP: Pandemic unemployment assistance payments, pandemic unemployment compensation, and pandemic emergency unemployment compensation authorized under CARES Act are considered unearned income for the purposes of determining a household's SNAP eligibility and benefit amount. These payments are treated consistently with non-pandemic unemployment benefits and not excluded from income for SNAP purposes.

Hope you are doing well. I was told Senator Hoeven's office was working closely with different Cares Act initiatives. As you may know, Standing Rock was awarded funding from the Department of Treasury. One of the proposals we received from Tribal Council was to do a disbursement of funds to enrollees. Question I have is, would any type of disbursement affect one's eligibility for state benefits? Such as: SNAP, MedicAid, etc The application states the funds would be used to cover incurred expenses due to COVID from March — December, but would be in a lump sum. Hoping you can assist, we are hearing two different answers so just trying to get a clear answer so I can take back to Tribal Council.
