Two taken into custody following pharmacy break-in

Mandan, N.D. – The Morton County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) arrested two suspects within the past 24 hours who broke in to the Glen Ullin Pharmacy on Main Street in Glen Ullin this past weekend.

At approximately 5:50am on Saturday, April 20, two individuals made a forcible entry through the back door of the pharmacy and stole large quantities of narcotics to include oxycodone, OxyContin, fentanyl, and liquid morphine. Several MCSO deputies responded to an alarm alert from the pharmacy when the back door was compromised.

The MCSO, in conjunction with the Metro Area Narcotics Task Force, worked throughout the week to identify the suspects from video surveillance. Search warrants were obtained, and both suspects were arrested.

The names of the suspects will not be released until they are formally charged by the Morton County State's Attorney's Office. The suspects are currently being held at the Burleigh/Morton County Detention Center. The case remains under investigation.
