

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
August 13, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on August 13, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Strinden, Leingang and Buckley, Deputy Auditor Eckroth and States Attorney Kopyy.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Strinden seconded to approve the minutes of the July 28, 2020 regular meeting and August 4, 2020 Special Commission Meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to offer support for the 5 year extension to the Mandan Renaissance Zone Renewal & Expansion. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve the Morton County Development Fund in the amount of \$2500 to assist in the 2021 Community Event Calendar. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved to approve the 2020 levy dollar amount for Custer District Health equal to that of the 2019 levy dollar amount. Motion died for the lack of a seconded.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to appoint Donald LaFleur as the Morton County Tax Director with the annual salary of \$72,000 starting Monday, August 17, 2020. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to contract Mike Heilman as the Morton County Superintendent of Schools for approximately \$10,000 per year. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the bid from the low bidder, Butler Machinery, for the purchase of Three (3) Motorgraders and Wings and authorized the ordering of the Motorgraders and Wings for delivery in February 2021. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from July 29, 2020 through August 13, 2020 equals \$2,909,397.64.
