

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
September 22, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on September 22, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang and Buckley and Auditor Rhone. Commissioner Strinden was present virtually.

Leingang moved and Strinden seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the September 10, 2020 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Strinden seconded to approve the \$375 request from the Mandan Progress Organization contingent upon the approval of the EDC/Chamber executive committee approving this from Morton County Development Funds. Voting aye: Buckley, Strinden, Leingang, Schulz; voting nay: Zachmeier. Motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve the Resolution authorizing sales tax revenue refunding bonds for the joint detention center project. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve abatement #5582. All voting aye, motion carried.

The regular meeting was recessed at 6:00PM and the Public Hearing for the 2021 Budget was opened.

The Public Hearing was closed at 6:10 PM and the regular meeting was reconvened.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve the 2021 budget of \$25,117,502 and a tax levy of \$11,798,235. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the request to house a grant funded employee who will serve as the southwest Vision Zero coordinator in partnership with NDACo and NDDOT. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from September 11, 2020 through September 22, 2020 equals \$86,912.27.
