

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
April 13, 2017

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on April 13, 2017 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Leingang, Zachmeier, Boehm and Strinden, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Koppy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the March 28, 2017 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the bills and payroll with the exception of Berg's Towing. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang to approve Berg's Towing of \$7500 coming out of the Sheriff and States Attorneys Budget. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Strinden seconded to authorize Auditor Rhone to notify the South Central District Court Administration that the court will have to vacate offices 230 & 231 effective 6/30/2017 to be given to the City Municipal Court. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve the contract with Al Fitterer Architect PC for Architectural Services for remodel of the former Custer Health Space. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Boehm seconded to approve the temporary position for the Road Department not to exceed 800 hours in 2017. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve abatement #5013 for the adjustment on taxation from taxable to non-taxable in favor of Mandan 94 Investors LLP. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #5014-5019 duplicate assessments. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve Homestead Credit Abatements #5020-5022. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve Fire Emergency and Burn Ban for Morton County as presented by Emergency Management Director. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from March 29, 2017 through April 13, 2017, equals \$2,372,315.77. A detailed list of funds expended by check is available for public inspection anytime during regular business hours at the Morton County Auditor's Office.
