

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
April 25, 2017

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on April 25, 2017 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Leingang, Zachmeier, Boehm and Strinden, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Kopyy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda with additions. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2017 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Strinden seconded to approve the bills. All voting aye, motion carried.

Brent Ekstrom, Lewis Clark Regional Development Council, updated the County Commission on what the LCRDC is doing for Morton County and the new programs that are available.

Tanner Schweitzer, ND Country Fest and Medieval Rush, gave an overview of events.

Leingang moved and Boehm seconded to authorize the county engineer to dispose of equipment and vehicles as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to award the 2017 concrete culvert supply to Forterra and the 2017 metal culvert supply to True North Steel. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve the Certification of Significant Community Support for Glen Ullin ND. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Strinden seconded to approve the lease agreement with the City of Mandan Municipal Court to be located within the Morton County courthouse with the discussed changed. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve out of state travel for Assistant States Attorney Goter to attend the SD States Attorney Convention in Deadwood SD. All voting aye, motion carried.
