

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
April 26, 2022

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on April 26, 2022 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Boehm at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang, Buckley, Morrell and Auditor Rhone. Also present was States Attorney Koppy.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2022 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve out of state travel for Treasurer Hatzenbuhler to attend the NACCTFO Conference in Denver on July 17-19, 2022. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve First International Bank & Trust as the main depository. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve Morton County depositories for 2022 as presented by the Treasurer. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Leingang seconded to approve requests from the Morton County Fair Board for water and electric upgrades and building improvements totaling \$217,644, pending final approval from the City of New Salem and the New Salem Park Board. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from March 30, 2022 through April 26, 2022 equals \$3,201,526.14.
