

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
April 28, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on April 28, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz. The meeting was held virtually with Commissioners Zachmeier, Strinden, Leingang and Buckley, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Kopyy present via teleconference.

Leingang moved and Strinden seconded to approve the agenda with an addition. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2020 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #5339-5340. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #5343. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve the temporary emergency paid sick leave policy due to COVID-19 as presented by the HR Director. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Strinden seconded to authorize the first payment to Mr Gange per the agreement regarding the structure located in Ft Rice and that Assistant State Attorney Goter will authorize the second and third payments when compliance is met. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Strinden seconded to hold a Special Meeting of the Planning & Zoning Board to move the process along faster for the Maverick Estates subdivision. All voting aye, motion carried.
