Emergency services within Morton County receive \$20,000 donation

Mandan, N.D. – Tonight, Energy Transfer Partners (ETP) presented a check for \$20,000 to Morton County Emergency Management which will be used to defray costs for emergency service providers' various needs within the county.

Glen Ullin, New Salem, Hebron, Almont and Flasher volunteer fire and ambulance services will each receive \$1,000. Mandan Rural Fire Department will be given \$3,000 to off-set the cost of purchasing a set of rescue air bags, which are commonly used to extricate someone trapped beneath an object. The remaining \$7,000 will be utilized by Morton County Emergency Management to upgrade an emergency generator used for emergency operations and the Law Enforcement Center.

“We are very grateful for the generous donation from ETP that will allow emergency service agencies within Morton County – many operated entirely by volunteers – to purchase important life-saving equipment,” said Morton County Emergency Manager Tom Doering.

The check presentation was held at the Mandan Rural Fire Station where fire chiefs and EMTs from across the county gathered to accept the donation.
