Boil order lifted for Glen Ullin water supply

Mandan, N.D. – A boil order put in place on May 15 is now lifted for the City of Glen Ullin’s water supply. The boil order was lifted at 1:00 p.m. today when the ND State Laboratory determined the water was safe for consumption.

The water tower is back in use and water pressure in Glen Ullin should be adequate.

Morton County sent a CodeRED Emergency Notification System (reverse 911) call today to let residents know the order has been lifted.

On Monday, a breach in the water facility created the potential for contamination of the drinking water with disease causing microorganisms. The City put a boil order in place, informing residents to boil their water before consumption.

The area of the breach was corrected and the water storage facility was drained, scoured, and disinfected. The distribution system was flushed and samples were taken.
