

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
February 11, 2021

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on February 11, 2021 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Leingang at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Buckley, Boehm and Morrell and Auditor Rhone. States Attorney Koppy was present virtually.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the agenda with a change. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the January 26, 2021 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Boehm seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve the request from The Wet Spot to allow individuals under the age of 21 up until 9pm, complying with all applicable state and county ordinances for the purpose of consuming a meal. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve abatements #5903 & 5916. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve abatements #5904-5909, 5917 & 5920. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatement #5910. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve abatements #5911-5912. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve abatement #5913. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatements #5914-5915. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Buckley seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Rusch Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Residential (R) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and as the subdivision is not in violation of policy 1.1.2 of the 2045 Comprehensive Plan with the condition that the applicants apply for a permit to place the new mobile home. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Hoff Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Residential (R) District as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and is not in violation of policy 1.1.2 of the 2045 Comprehensive Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form Subdivision known as Belohlavek Subdivision and a zoning map amendment for lot 6 only from Agricultural (A) District to Residential (R) District as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and is not in violation of policy 1.1.2 of 2045 Comprehensive Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Planning & Zoning Director Pierce presented a briefing on the Harmon Lake dam breach overlay district.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the following budget amendments: 2021 budget: transfer 30,000 from the general fund to the Radio Replacement fund and increase the Sheriff's capital outlay by \$15,500; 2020 budget to transfer \$35,179.85 from the 24/7 program to the general fund for salary reimbursement of the 24/7 coordinator. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve the purchase of 3-DVM-800 in car video systems with asset forfeiture funds in the amount of \$12,165. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from January 27, 2020 through February 11, 2021 equals \$11,088,044.93.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to adjourn at 7:21PM. All voting aye, motion carried.
