

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
February 14, 2019

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on February 14, 2019 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota.
