

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
February 26, 2019

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on February 26, 2019 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Schulz and Buckley, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Koppy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda with a change. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Schulz seconded to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2019 meeting with a correction. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to adopt the Floating Holiday Policy as presented to commence March 2019 and added as an employee benefit. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the carryover of vacation hours for the Veterans Service Office and Emergency Management employees through June 30, 2019 and a payout for the States Attorney employees as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Schulz seconded to change Christmas Eve from a 4 to 8 hour paid holiday effective for the 2019 Christmas Eve. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatements #5221-5222. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Schulz seconded to approve abatement #5239. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #5240. All voting aye, motion carried.

Discussion took place on the Voigt et al/Pool complaint. The City of Mandan will be handling this through a zoning regulation violation.

Schulz moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the policing contracts with the Cities of New Salem, Glen Ullin & Hebron as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from February 15, 2019 through February 26, 2019, equals \$338,435.08.
