

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
January 13, 2022

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on January 13, 2022 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Leingang at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Buckley, Boehm and Morrell, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Koppy.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the agenda with an addition. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve the minutes of the December 28, 2021 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Morrell seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Chairman Leingang released the chair for reorganization of the Board of Commission to Auditor Rhone.

Rhone called for nominations for Chairman.

Leingang nominated Boehm for Chairman.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to cease nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Boehm. All voting aye, motion carried.

Rhone called for nominations for Vice-Chairman.

Leingang nominated Zachmeier for Vice-Chairman.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to cease nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Zachmeier for Vice-Chairman. All voting aye, motion carried.

Rhone released the chair to Chairman Boehm.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded authorize NDSU to open the application process to fill the Family & Community Wellness Coordinator position with the position's emphasis being 65% or greater in community and leadership development. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatement #6025. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #6026-6027. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatements #6028-6029. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from December 29, 2021 through January 13, 2022 equals \$11,977,463.64.
