

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
January 25, 2022

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on January 25, 2022 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Boehm at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Leingang, Buckley and Morrell and Auditor Rhone.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the agenda with an addition. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the January 13, 2022 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Commissioner Zachmeier arrived at 5:51.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded approve the request from Hebron Brick for \$50,000 of the Morton County Development funds for their plant expansion. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve the refund of 2019 taxes for parcel 49-0035000 and 49-0036000 in the amount of \$3,007.11. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #6030. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #6031. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatement #6032. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatements #6033-6039. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Morrell seconded to appoint Russell Leingang to the City of Mandan Planning & Zoning as a county representative for the extraterritorial zone (3 year term expiring 12/31/2025). All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve hiring a full-time building inspector/assessor position. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from January 14, 2022 through January 25, 2022 equals \$11,977,463.64.
