

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING
July 30, 2019

The Morton County Commission Special Meeting was called to order on July 30, 2019 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Schulz, Leingang and Buckley and Auditor Rhone.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the minutes of the July 23, 2019 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills. All voting aye, motion carried.

Missi Baranko from Lutheran Social Services presented information on their Healthy Families program and a request for \$15,000 in funding for 2020.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to deny the request from Lutheran Social Services for funding for the Healthy Families Program for 2020 due to Senate Bill 2124 and because similar services are provided by Custer Health. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the preliminary budget with a total budget of \$25,025,900 and a property tax levy of \$12,212,576. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from July 24, 2019 through July 30, 2019 equals \$2,457.93.
