

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING

June 10, 2019

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on June 10, 2019 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Schulz, Leingang, Buckley and Zachmeier, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Koppy.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the May 28, 2019 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Chairman Strinden opened a public hearing on the formation of a Human Service Zone with Grant and Sioux Counties at 5:32.

Social Service Director Meier gave an overview and timeline on the requirements of creating a Social Services zone.

Chairman Strinden closed the public hearing at 5:41.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the Resolution to form a Joint Tri-County Human Services Zone with Grant and Sioux Counties. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to appoint Tom Conlon and Maxine Rugland to the County School Reorganization Board to 3 year terms expiring on 6/30/21. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to appoint Del Wetsch to a 3 year term expiring 7/1/22 on the Social Services Board. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to appoint Randy Graner, Jamie Wetsch and Ken Geiger to 3 year terms expiring 6/30/22 on the Morton County Park Board. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Buckley seconded to appoint Shauna Laber to an unexpired term expiring on 12/31/20 on the Lower Heart Water District Board. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from May 10, 2019 through May 28, 2019 equals \$1,351,883.43.
