

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
June 10, 2021

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on June 10, 2021 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Leingang at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Boehm and Morrell, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Kopyy. Commissioner Buckley was absent.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the May 25, 2021 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Information was presented on the Area IV Soil Conservation District Cooperative Research Farm possible land purchase.

The meeting was recessed at 6:00 PM for the Board of Equalization meeting.

The meeting was reconvened at 7:41 PM.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the final plat of a short-form subdivision known as Dolls Paradise Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) and Residential (R) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and is not in violation of Policy 1.1.2 of the Morton County Comprehensive Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Morrell seconded to approve the final plat of a short-form subdivision known as Edens Meadow 2nd Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) and Residential (R) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and as the purpose of the subdivision is to re-define the boundary of the original Edens Meadow Subdivision. All voting aye, motion carried.

Commissioner Buckley joined the meeting virtually.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the final plat of a short-form subdivision known as AJ Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) and Residential (R) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code, is compatible with surrounding land uses, and is not in violation of Policy 1.1.2 (g) of the Morton County Comprehensive Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve Policy 800-005, Media Relations. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve Policy 600-002, Keys & Pass Cards. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve Policy 100-006, Responsible Official. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve Policy 200-008, Bills Approval. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from May 26, 2021 through June 10, 2021 equals \$1,738,981.74.
