

MORTON COUNTY TAX EQUALIZATION MEETING

June 4, 2020

The Morton County Board of Tax Equalization Meeting was called to order on June 4, 2020, at 6:04 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Strinden, Leingang and Buckley, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Kopyy.

Buckley moved and Strinden seconded to approve the 2020 City of Mandan valuation of \$2,171,386,690. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the 2020 City of Hebron valuation of \$35,420,100. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the 2020 City of Almont valuation of \$5,140,500. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the 2020 City of Flasher valuation of \$10,958,400. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve the 2020 City of Glen Ullin valuation of \$36,071,600. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the 2020 City of New Salem valuation of \$56,179,100. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Strinden seconded to approve the 2020 Captains Landing Township valuation of \$19,228,500. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve the 2020 value of all agricultural parcels located in the unorganized townships of Morton County at a 5.02% increase from the 2019 values. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the 2020 total Morton County value of \$3,648,608,690. All voting aye, motion carried.
