1. Monthly updates

Design Projects –Little Heart Bridge – Interstate Engineering; Wenk Engineering Environmental Permit still at the Army Corps of Engineers. Youngtown – AE2S continuing design work on Concrete Box Culvert. Completed Documented CATEX for CR139 Microsurface.

Construction / Culvert Replacements - Sims Bridge – Midwest Contracting, LLC of Marshall, MN work is on going, relocating existing bridge today. CR 83 Slide Repair is complete. Road to Salem Sue is complete.

Budget / Cash Flow information reviewed for May & June 2020.

2. Right of Way Width on 44th Street – Fred Berger purchased land due to change over the years of the center line of the road, the ditch and fence are on the Berger land. Recommendation of the Commission is to get area surveyed and buy the required Right of Way from Fred Berger.
3. Reviewed budget presented to the full commission. Included three Motorgraders and one Tar Tank.
4. Willow Road Special Assessment update. Two property owners are in the process of gathering signatures.
5. Request to lower speed limit on CR 138 near ND Highway 6. Recommendation to do nothing.
