

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
March 11, 2021

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on March 11, 2021 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Leingang at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Buckley, Boehm and Morrell, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Koppy

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the February 23, 2021 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Boehm seconded to approve abatement #5928. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #5929-5930. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the total burn ban for all of Morton County as presented by Emergency Manager Mattson. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Maier Subdivision, and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Estate (E) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Price Shoemaker Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Industrial (I) District as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and that the road right of way be adjusted to 50 feet instead of 40 feet. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Morrell seconded to approve the bid from Vic Fleck Excavating in the amount of \$124.75 per hour for contract gravel hauling and \$70 per working day for mobilization. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the purchase of a mobile file unit in the amount of \$43,283.35 with \$30,000 to be paid out of the States Attorney forfeiture account and \$13,283.35 to be paid out of the States Attorney's Capital Outlay. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from February 24, 2020 through March 11, 2021 equals \$15,661,697.67.
