

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
May 14, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on May 14, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz. The meeting was held virtually with Commissioners Zachmeier, Strinden, Leingang and Buckley, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Kopyy present via teleconference.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the April 28, 2020 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatement #5344. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #5346-5347. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve filling the vacant position in Emergency Management. Voting aye: Strinden, Zachmeier, Strinden, Buckley; voting nay: Schulz. Motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve the bids for culverts from True North Steel and Forterra as presented by the County Engineer. All voting aye, motion carried.
