

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
May 24, 2022

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on May 24, 2022 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Boehm at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang, Buckley, Morrell and Auditor Rhone. Also present was States Attorney Kopyy.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2022 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #6085-6087. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Morrell seconded to send the Right-of-Way policy back to the Road Commission for the following reasons:

1. Policy needs to be brought into standard of policies that was adopted by the county
2. Include reference to NDDOT policy that governs this overall policy
3. Better study the ramifications of using tax dollars to purchase right-of-way or easement that the county is currently empowered to use

All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to appoint Jamie Wetsch, Randy Graner and Ken Geiger to 3 year terms on the County Park Board expiring 6/30/2025. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from May 13, 2022 through May 24, 2022 equals \$577,381.19.
