

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING  
May 9, 2019

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on May 9, 2019 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Schulz, Leingang and Zachmeier, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Koppy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger. Absent was Commissioner Buckley.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda with changes. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Schulz seconded to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2019 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Brian Ritter from the Bismarck Mandan Chamber/EDC gave an update on the organization.

Schulz moved and Zachmeier seconded to award the bid for installation of a septic system for the Sweet Briar shop in the amount of \$4,100 to Clay's Plumbing & Heating. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Schulz seconded to award the 2019 bid for galvanized corrugated metal pipe to TrueNorth Steel and the bid for concrete culvert pipe to Forterra Concrete Products, Inc. All voting aye, motion carried.

Jodie Fetsch of Custer District Health gave an update on the Good Neighbor Project – Free Needle Exchange for Intravenous Illegal Drug Users.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to appoint Jesse Kist to an unexpired term expiring on 6/30/2020 on the Morton County Park Board. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from April 24, 2019 through May 9, 2019 equals \$2,584,789.46.
