4.0306 Reports Every fire of any kind, and from whatever source, occurring in or about any hotel, rooming house, lodging house or apartment hotel in the City of New Salem shall be reported immediately to the Fire Department.

ARTICLE 4 Firearms, Fireworks and Explosives

4.0401 Firearms not to be Furnished to Minors

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell, furnish or rent firearms to minors within the limits of this city.

4.0402 Exploding Firearms and BB Guns It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fire or discharge within the city limits of this city, any cannon, gun, fowling piece, pistol or other firearms of any description without the written permission of the City Council, which permit shall limit the time of such firing and be subject to the revocation by the City Council at any time after being granted. Provided, however, that nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to the firing of any gun or other firearms when done in cases of actual necessity, or in the performance of lawful duty, or by militia companies or veterans organizations when on parade or during military ceremonies.

Any BB gun, pellet gun, compressed air device, rubber band or spring operated device capable of firing or propelling a BB, pellet, or other such projectile shall be prohibited from use within the city limits.

4.0403 Blank Cartridges, Pistols, etc. - Manufacture, Use and Sale of

No person except a licensed dealer, shall manufacture, use, sell or keep for sale within the City of New Salem, North Dakota, any blank cartridges, pistols, blank cartridge revolver or other blank cartridge firearms, blank cartridge caps containing dynamite or fire-crackers exceeding three (3) inches in length and exceeding one-half (½) inch in diameter.

4.0404 Fireworks Defined As used in this article, the term "fireworks" means any substance or combination of substances or articles prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by explosion or detonation, and includes blank cartridges, toy cannons and toy canes in which explosives are used, the type of balloons which require fire underneath to propel them, firecrackers, torpedoes, sky rockets, roman candles, daygo bombs or other fireworks of like construction, and any fireworks containing any explosive or compound, or any tablets, or other device containing any explosive substance and commonly used as fireworks. The term "fireworks" shall not include toy pistols, toy guns in which paper caps containing twenty-five hundredths grains or less of explosive compound

are used, and toy pistol caps which contain less than twenty hundredths grains of explosive mixtures.

4.0405 Fireworks - Discharging of, Sale of The provisions of Chapter 23-15 of the North Dakota Century Code shall apply to the sale and/or use of fireworks, as defined in said Chapter 23-15, within the City of New Salem, North Dakota, subject however to the following additions, deletions or exceptions:

1. In the fire zone of the municipality of New Salem, the discharge of.....any bottle rockets, torpedoes, or any kind of ROCKET is prohibited. Dealers in the municipality of New Salem who sell said articles or items shall post notice in a conspicuous place in their place of business so that such notice is easily visible to the public giving notice of all prohibitions regarding the discharging of fireworks within the City of New Salem under penalty of law.
2. The use, firing, or discharging of any bottle rockets, torpedoes, or anything of its kind is expressly prohibited at any time whatsoever within the city limits of New Salem.
3. Fireworks or other such related devices may not be sold or discharged within the city limits before June 27th or after July 5th.
4. Fireworks or other such related devices shall not be discharged within the City limits between the hours of 1:00 AM and 8 AM except for on June 27th the evening hour shall be only until 12 midnight.

4.0406 Exceptions Nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit the sale or use of fireworks to airplanes, railroads and other transportation agencies for signal purposes or illumination, or the sale or use of blank cartridges for a show or theater, or for signal or ceremonial purposes in athletics or sports, or for use by military organizations.

ARTICLE 5 Adoption of Electrical Code

4.0501 Electrical Code Adopted There is hereby adopted the laws and regulations and wiring standards of North Dakota adopted by the State Electrical Board and the whole thereof of which not less than one (1) copy shall be on file in the office of the City Auditor of the city, and the same is hereby adopted as fully as if it were set out at length herein.

ARTICLE 6 Penalty for Violation of this Chapter

4.0601 Penalty Any person who shall violate any provisions of this chapter or who shall fail to comply with any order as affirmed or modified by the governing body or court of competent jurisdiction enforcing the provisions of this chapter shall

be guilty of an offense and be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00). The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue; and all such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time. The application of the above penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.
