November 12, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on November 12, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz who was attending virtually. Present at the Morton County Courthouse were Commissioners Zachmeier and Leingang with Strinden, Buckley, Auditor Rhone and States Attorney Koppy present virtually.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda with an addition. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the minutes of the October 27, 2020 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Strinden seconded to approve the annual Maintenance Certification for County Federal Aid Projects with the NDDOT. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to withhold the 2021 funds allocated to the County Fair until such time as the recommendations of the County Auditor and Tax Directors office are acted upon to the satisfaction of the County Commission. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Strinden seconded to confirm the emergency mask policy required on county property that was instituted on 11-9-2020. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from September 23, 2020 through October 8, 2020 equals \$1,772,655.18.
