

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
October 8, 2020

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on October 8, 2020 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang and Buckley and Auditor Rhone. Commissioner Strinden was present virtually.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the September 22, 2020 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #5584-5759, 5769-5787, 5789-5800, 5802-5809 & 5818. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatements # 5760-5764, 5788 & 5817. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #5765-5766. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #5768 with a land value of \$3,500. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatement #5815. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve abatement #5816. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Leingang seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Brunen Subdivision and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Residential (R) District, as the subdivision conforms to the regulations established in Article 7 of the Morton County Land Use Code and as the subdivision is not in violation of policy 1.1.2 of the 2045 Comprehensive Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the final plat of the short-form subdivision known as Johnsons Wrecking Subdivision, and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Industrial (I) District, as the subdivision would reduce existing non-conformities, with the condition that the applicant will have removed from the premises the southernmost residential structure on the property prior to the recording of the plat. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to appoint Robyn Theil and Dennis Gustin to the County School Reorganization Board with the terms expiring on 6/30/2023. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from September 23, 2020 through October 8, 2020 equals \$1,587,511.92.
