

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING

September 27, 2022

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on September 27, 2022 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Boehm at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang, Buckley, Morrell and Auditor Rhone. Also present was States Attorney Koppy and Sheriff Kirchmeier.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve the agenda as amended. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the September 8, 2022 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve abatement #6101. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatement #6102. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatements #6111-6112. All voting aye, motion carried.

Chairman Boehm opened the public hearing on the 2022 tax levy at 6PM.

Virginia Gall addressed the commission regarding her property value and she was directed to reach out to the City of Mandan regarding that question.

Chairman Boehm closed the public hearing on the 2022 tax levy at 6:04PM.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve the 2022 tax levy at \$13,529,624. Voting aye: Morell, Buckley, Zachmeier, Leingang, Boehm. Motion Carried.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve abatements #6113-6115. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve abatement #6116. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve abatements #6117-6119. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the Resolution to promulgate Morton County's Local Emergency Operations Plan dated September 19, 2022. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Morrell seconded to accept the low bids of Quality Dirtworks, LLC of \$593,950.32 for replacement of Br. No. 30-153-04.0; Edward Schwartz Construction, Inc of \$1,187,697.60 for replacement of Br. No. 30-168-37.0; and Midwest Contracting of \$553,414.00

for replacement of Br. No. 30-165-36.0. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve policy 700-009, Snow Removal. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley to approve the minimum sales prices of the tax foreclosure properties as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve Policy 100-008, Courthouse Building Structures and Building Improvements. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morell moved and Zachmeier seconded to appoint Commissioner Buckley as the 2022 Morton County State Fair delegate. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from September 9, 2022 through September 27, 2022 equals \$1,659,730.00.
