

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
August 22, 2017

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on August 22, 2017 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Schulz at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Leingang, Boehm and Strinden, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Kopyy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger.

Strinden moved and Boehm seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Strinden seconded to approve the minutes of the August 10, 2017 regular meeting and the August 16, 2017 special meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Boehm seconded to approve the bills. All voting aye, motion carried.

Strinden moved and Leingang seconded to allow the new Veterans' Service Officer to work alongside the current VSO for 2 months with an option for a third month if needed. All voting aye, motion carried.

Keith Johnson presented the 2018 Budget for Custer District Health.
Rocky Bateman and Beth McCleary presented the 2018 Morton County Soil Conservation District budget.
Nancy Keating presented the 2018 budget request for Centre Inc.

Leingang moved and Strinden seconded to approve homestead credit abatement #5045. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve reassessment abatement #5046. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to accept the two lowest bids (Sundre Sand and Gravel Inc & Fisher Sand and Gravel Co) and approve the gravel crushing contract with Sundre Sand and Gravel Inc at the rate of \$5.38/CY. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from August 11, 2017 through August 22, 2017, equals \$309,943.76. A detailed list of funds expended by check is available for public inspection anytime during regular business hours at the Morton County Auditor's Office.
