

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
December 14, 2017

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on December 14, 2017, at 5:30 PM by Vice-Chairman Strinden at the Glen Ullin Blue Room, 201 Main Street S, Glen Ullin, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Boehm and Leingang and Auditor Rhone. Absent was Chairman Schulz.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda with an addition. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve the minutes of the November 28, 2017 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve bills. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to appoint Mitchell Erhardt as the Morton County Veterans' Service Officer. All voting aye, motion carried.

Casey Anderson, Assistant Chief of the Wildlife Division of the ND Game & Fish, presented information on a notice of intent to acquire a 78 acre tract of land in Morton County by the ND Game & Fish located in the NE ¼ of Section 36 Township 140 Range 87.

Leingang moved and Boehm seconded to approve the Resolution of Promulgation of Local Emergency Operations Plan. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve reassessment abatement #5071. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve homestead credit abatements #5072-5074. All voting aye, motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Strinden opened a public hearing at 6:00 PM to discuss the Redesignation of the Morton County Recorder from elected to appointed and the Combination of Morton County Treasurer and Auditor.

County Treasurer Lippert discussed some concerns and asked some questions on the Combination of the County Treasurer and Auditor offices.

Vice-Chairman Strinden closed the public hearing at 6:22 PM.
