

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING

March 27, 2018

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on March 27, 2018 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Leingang, Zachmeier Boehm and Schulz, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Kopyy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Schulz seconded to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2018 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Schulz moved and Boehm seconded to approve Joel Rostberg to be appointed to the NRG Technology Board of Directors. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded approve out of state travel for Kari Pressler from the Extension Office to attend State 4-H training in Sioux Falls, SD. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved to retain the services of Mr. Tom Bair under NDCC 11-16-08 for the purpose of quiet title for Greenwood Cemetery and Fairview/Timmer Ladies Aid Cemetery so that the County can take ownership as an abandoned cemetery under NDCC 23-06-30. Motion died for lack of a second.

Schulz moved and Leingang seconded to approve the proposed 911 Resolution and ballot language as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Boehm seconded to authorize advertising for 2018 Gravel Crushing & Stockpiling and for the 2018 Supply of Concrete & Metal Culverts. All voting aye, motion carried.

Leingang moved and Schulz seconded authorize advertising for project SRF-0030(046) PCN22138, Graner Park Bituminous Overlay. All voting aye, motion carried.

The total of all county funds expended from March 16, 2018 through March 27, 2018, equals \$599,230.08
