

MORTON COUNTY COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING
October 27, 2015

The Morton County Commission Regular Meeting was called to order on October 27, 2015 at 5:30 PM by Chairman Strinden at the Morton County Courthouse, 210 Second Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota. Others present were Commissioners Zachmeier, Boehm and Leingang, Auditor Rhone, States Attorney Kopy and Assistant States Attorney Grosinger. Absent was Commissioner Schulz.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the amended minutes of the July 9, 2015 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Zachmeier seconded to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2015 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve bills and payroll. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve reassessment abatements #4767-4770. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the Assessing Contract with the City of Flasher effective 10/31/15. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve the final plat of a short form subdivision known as Pulkrabek Acres and a zoning map amendment from Agricultural (A) District to Residential (R) District for approximately 2 acres in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 22, Township 138N, Range 82W Morton County. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve the final plat of a short form subdivision known as Riverside Ranch Subdivision for approximately 6 acres in the N ½ of the N ½ of Section 21 Township 137N Range 80W Morton County. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to waive the \$50 Special Use Permit fee for Chad Berger. All voting aye, motion carried.

Boehm moved and Leingang seconded to approve a gravel lease with Donald & Larry Freisz located in SE ¼ of Section 34, Township 136N, Range 83W, for \$2 per cubic yard for 25,000 cubic yards, with 300 cubic yards to go to the owner. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to keep the Courthouse open on the Friday after Thanksgiving. Voting aye: Zachmeier, Boehm, Strinden; voting nay: Leingang. Motion Carried.

Zachmeier moved and Leingang seconded to approve out of state travel for Gabriel Goter to attend the Multi-Disciplinary Team Response to the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children in Omaha, Nebraska on November 16-19, 2015. All voting aye, motion carried.
