First let me introduce myself, I am Lori Heinsohn your new program Manager for the ACT classes. I also wanted to inform you that starting in April of 2019, BSC will be going to an online format for Unlawful Possession of Alcohol (MIP) and Adult Drug and Alcohol. This decision is as result of our meeting with Burleigh County District court as well as to sustain the program offerings. The courts will be notified of the online offerings as the details become available.

Below is the Classroom ACT Class Schedule for 2019.

January 12th – 2019 (Both Unlawful Possession of Alcohol and Adult Misdemeanor)
February 9th – 2019 (Unlawful Possession of Alcohol)
March 23rd – 2019 (Unlawful Possession of Alcohol)

Registration Fee: \$75.00 Students must pay in advance of the class by registering online at actatbsc.com or by calling BSC continuing education at (701) 224-5600. Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Class Location: Bismarck State College, National Energy Center of Excellence building, 1200 Schafer St., Bismarck, Room 107 Lower Level 1st floor. Students should park in south parking lot & enter south side of building.

Class Time: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Students are to arrive 15 minutes early for check in at room 107). Those arriving after course starts will not be admitted to class.
